



Question 22 RE: **NOT** Speaking at Town Meeting





Preparing for Town Meeting

Wealth of information, many outside meetings - Where to focus efforts? What's reasonable to expect from TM Members? And how best to synthesize all that information?

Timing and delivery of information

The earlier the better; make more available electronically

Debate & questions

Too much repetition in debate; too many questions posed that have been answered in reports or presentations; too many questions with long preambles; a sense that we hear from the same voices

Meeting duration

- Members overwhelmingly positive about ending before April vacation, but late nights are taxing!
- Enthusiasm for time-saving innovations like consent agenda
