The School Committee is responsible for the fingerprint process of the Superintendent and some other administrators, the Superintendent is responsible for all other employees. Fingerprinting is required once of each employee, in contrast to the CORI process which is required every three years. While the law states that the employee is responsible for the cost, the Lexington Education Association has indicated they intend to bargain the item.
