METCO Extended Learning Program (MELP)

- 3rd Year
- 40 students 2nd-5th
- Provides small group instruction in math and literacy
- Naturally creates affinity groups where they see themselves as learners

MATHpath Summer Program

- 2nd year
- 4 week program
- 8 incoming 6th graders
- 8 incoming 7th graders
- 3 days of efficacy training

- Instructional level for each student determined by pretest
- Individual and small group instruction at instructional level
- Mastery determined by assessments


Student Surveys (N=17)

- "I enjoyed learning during MATHpath"
 65% All or Most of the time
- "I was consistently engaged in the math learning"
 - 88% Most or Some of the time
- "My skills improved as a result of my participation in MATHpath"
 - 94% Strongly Agree or Agree

METCO Extended Day

- Diamond 4 times a week
- Clarke 1 time a week
- Students receive support in all subject areas

Diamond's Extended Day



- Currently 30 enrolled
- Students work in grade level
- Supported by two coordinators and teacher volunteers
- Goal to complete homework
- Greater sense of connection to the Diamond community

Diamond Extended Day



Clarke's Homework Club

- Teacher prioritizes with the students on their individual needs
- Other teachers volunteer to support students



Clarke METCO Tutoring

- 8 students receive tutoring
- Students work with the tutor 1 to 2 times a week in small groups
- Focus on content, organization, and overall support

- Freshman Academic Achievers Program

Freshman Academic Achievers Program

- Goal is to assist students with transition into high school, develop strong study skills, and self-advocacy
- Meets weekly during X block
- All METCO freshman are required to attend first quarter
- If they earn a C+ or better they can opt out of the program
- Many students remain due to the positive relationships with teachers


Freshman Academic Achievers Program

- Being a part of the 300 club



- Support students: time management, organizational skills, development of communication and self-advocacy skills

- Implemented with METCO freshmen in the 2nd quarter...and Extended Day students at Diamond

- Students write an essay, receive recommendations, and are interviewed by the Scholars staff






MCAS Math - Grades 3-10 - Advanced and Proficent




MCAS - Grade 10 Math - Advanced and Proficient
