What role does, or should the Housing Authority take in seeking CPA funding for community housing related projects?

- 8. How does the Housing Authority collaborate with other state agencies to identify ways to pay for its projects? Are there any unexplored avenues for funding that you would like to pursue?
- 9. The Housing Authority is a different legal entity than LexHAB, though both work to address similar needs. What is the difference between what the Housing Authority and LexHAB do?
- 10. Over the last year, can you describe one issue which the Housing Authority handled very effectively? And one issue that could have been addressed better?
