- 1. Correction of information provided in "Response to Questions Regarding After School Structured Program for Elementary Students Request for Proposal" under #1A.
 - 1A. Estabrook Elementary School is only licensed for 75 students.
- 2. Correction of information provided in "Response to Questions Regarding After School Structured Program for Elementary Students Request for Proposal" under #3A.
 - 2A. Estabrook's Extended Day Program started in 1982.
- 3. Correction of information on Page 11 #15 of the RFP.
 - 3A. In the RFP, it states there are six extended day program sites. There are only five extended day programs in Lexington Public Schools. Bridge Elementary School students attend and are bussed to the Hastings Lextended Day Program.
- 4. Additional information relating to the "Response to Questions Regarding After School Structured Program for Elementary Students Request for Proposal" #5A. under Hastings Elementary School Tuition Rates.
 - 4A. The Hastings Elementary School Tuition Rates includes the cost of bussing the Bridge Elementary School students to the Hastings Lextended Day Program.
- 5. Correction of information provided in "Response to Questions Regarding After School Structured Program for Elementary Students Request for Proposal" under #1A Harrington Extended Day Students Licensed For.
 - 5A. Harrington Extended Day is currently licensed for 104 students.
