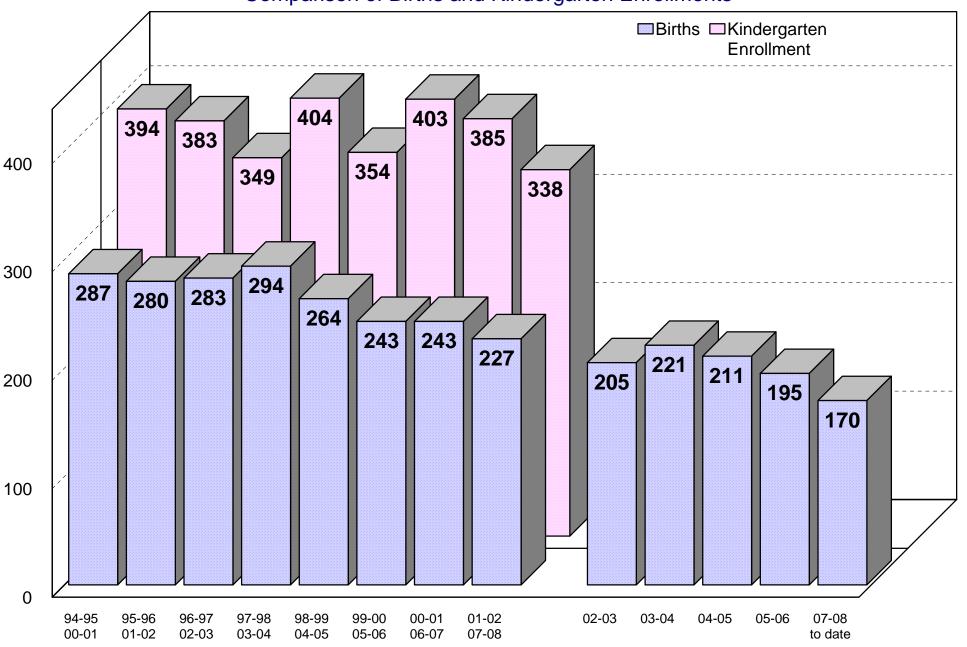

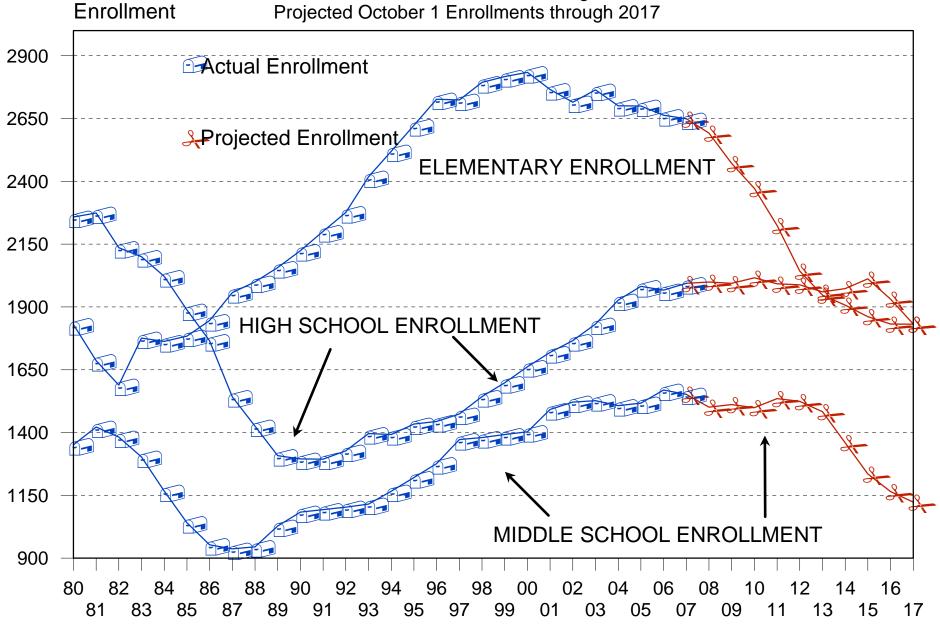
Lexington Public Schools Comparison of Births and Kindergarten Enrollments

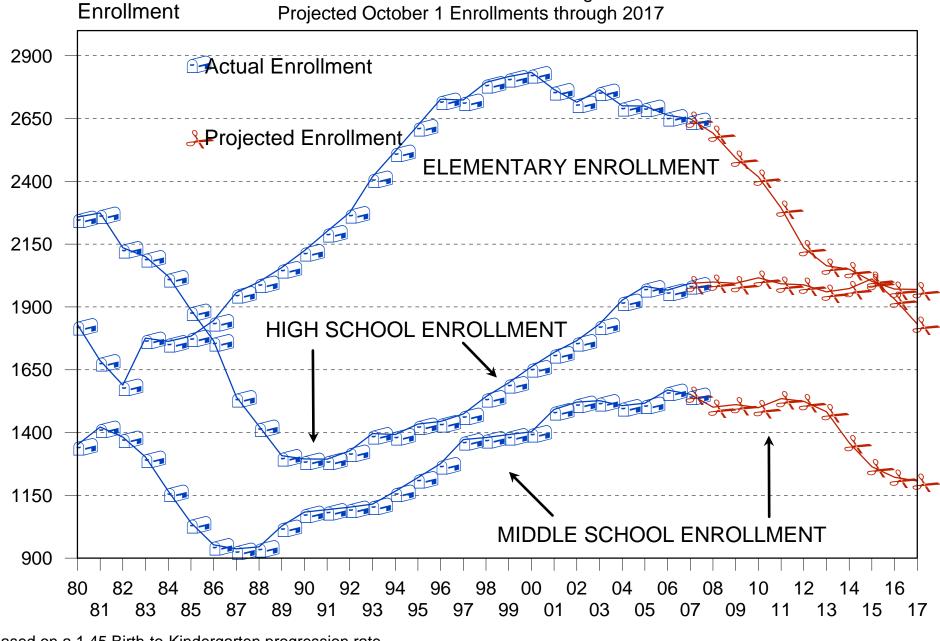
ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE SCHOOL and HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENTS Actual October 1 Enrollments through 2007

Actual October 1 Enrollments through 2007 Projected October 1 Enrollments through 2017

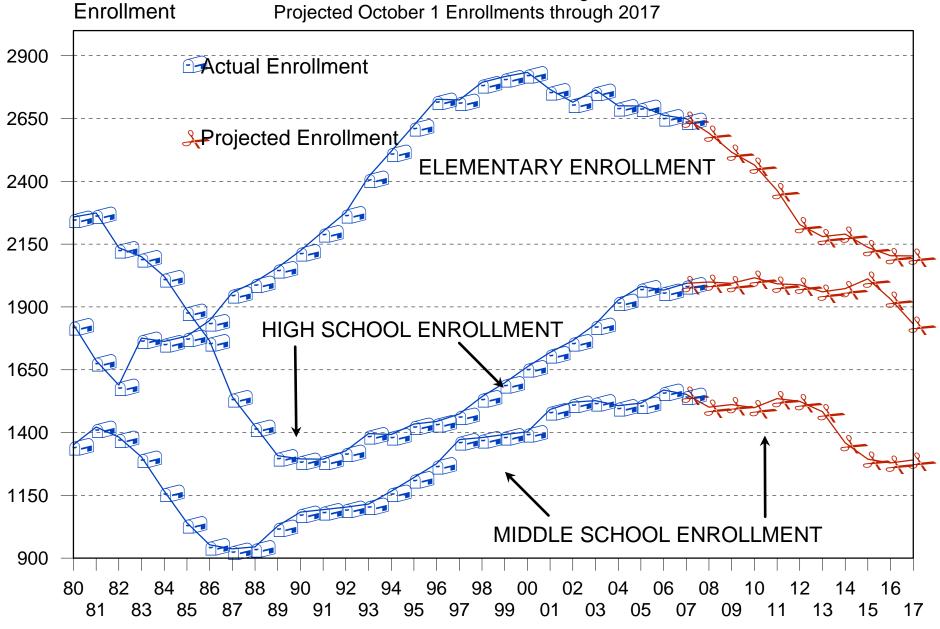
