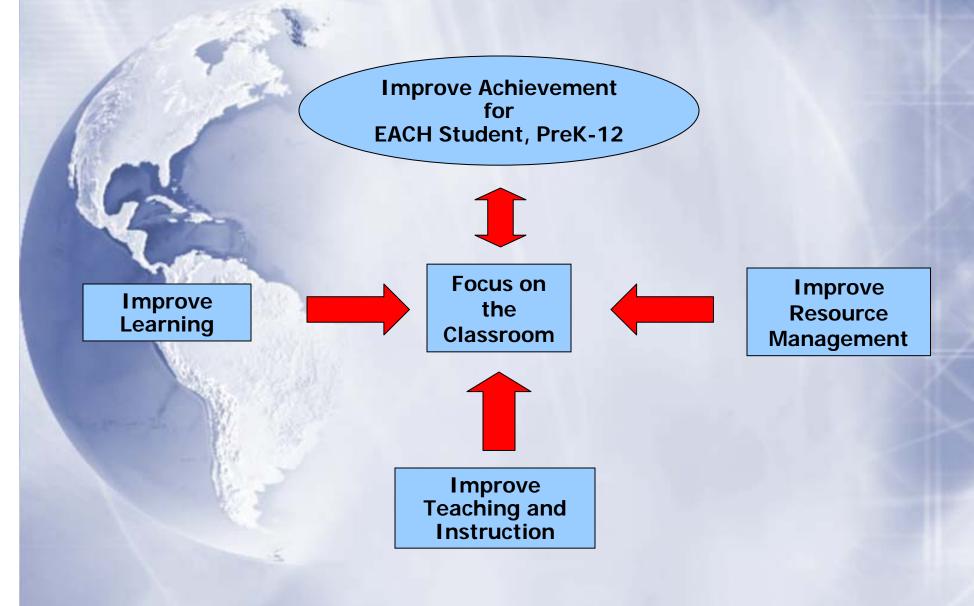

2008-2009 Areas of Focus Priorities and Strategies

The supplemental budget includes funds that will

- Expand K-5 literacy and K-5 mathematics intervention for for ALL students
- Expand in-house, high quality special education programs that will allow us to keep more students in the Lexington schools and reduce special tuition and transportation costs
- Continue Lexington's commitment to annual curriculum reviews (Begin the English review in FY 09)
- Eliminate the grades 4 & 5 instrumental music fee, which will make it possible for more students to learn to play a musical instrument

2008-2009 Areas of Focus Priorities and Strategies

- Offer full-day Kindergarten (if the state grant is approved)
- Provide needed teachers (0.2 guidance, 0.1 social worker,
 1.2 HS foreign language teachers)
- Provide needed support staff (e.g., secretaries transportation, K-12 curriculum, Medicaid reimbursement)
- Provide oversight to the HS student community service program (small stipend)
- Begin to restore K-12 professional development
- Expand the new teacher mentoring program that will improve instruction and teacher retention
